Objectives

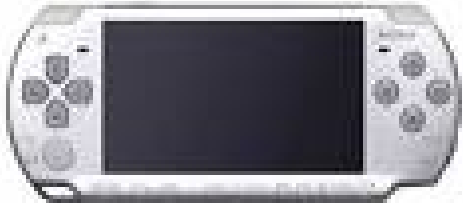
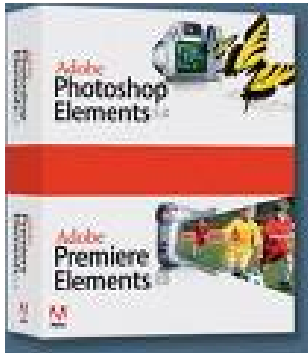
- > Motivate Infocomm Clubs to strive for excellence in infocomm and training;

Benefits For Schools

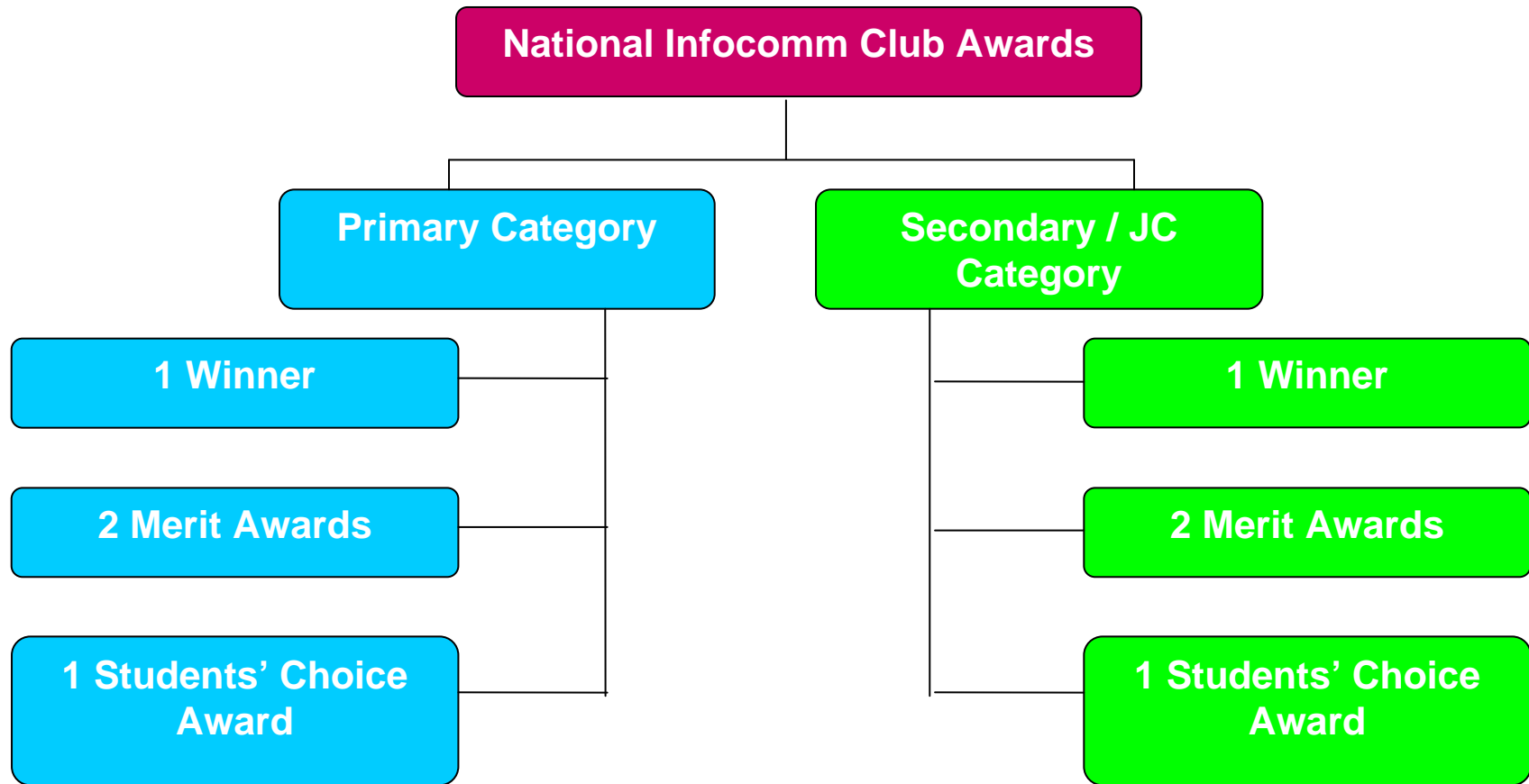
- > Receive Trophy and attractive prizes

Award Details

- > 2 rounds of judging
 - Internal Judging - Evaluation panel from IDA
 - External Judging - Representative from IDA, YOG, MOE, SCS, SITF, SSC

- > Award Distribution per Category
 - 6 best projects will be short-listed from all submitted projects
 - 3 top schools per category will be accorded 1 Distinction and 2 Merit Awards

Assessment Criteria

- > Impact (25%)
- > Infocomm skills (25%)
- > Innovation (20%)
- > Sustainability (15%)
- > Presentation skills (15%)

Award Guidelines

- > Schools can submit more than one project
- > Projects should demonstrate significant involvement, development and eventual execution by club members
- > Projects should demonstrate clearly the benefits reaped by the beneficiaries
- > Projects should be conceptualised and executed within the individual clubs' project qualifying period
- > Students should be prepared to present their projects to the judging panel

Award Guidelines

- > Clubs will submit their projects using an entry form signed by the Principal and sent via mail
- > Deadline for submission is 31 July 2009
- > Results will be announced at the Awards Ceremony in November 2009
