 - Attract infocomm inclined students to their schools

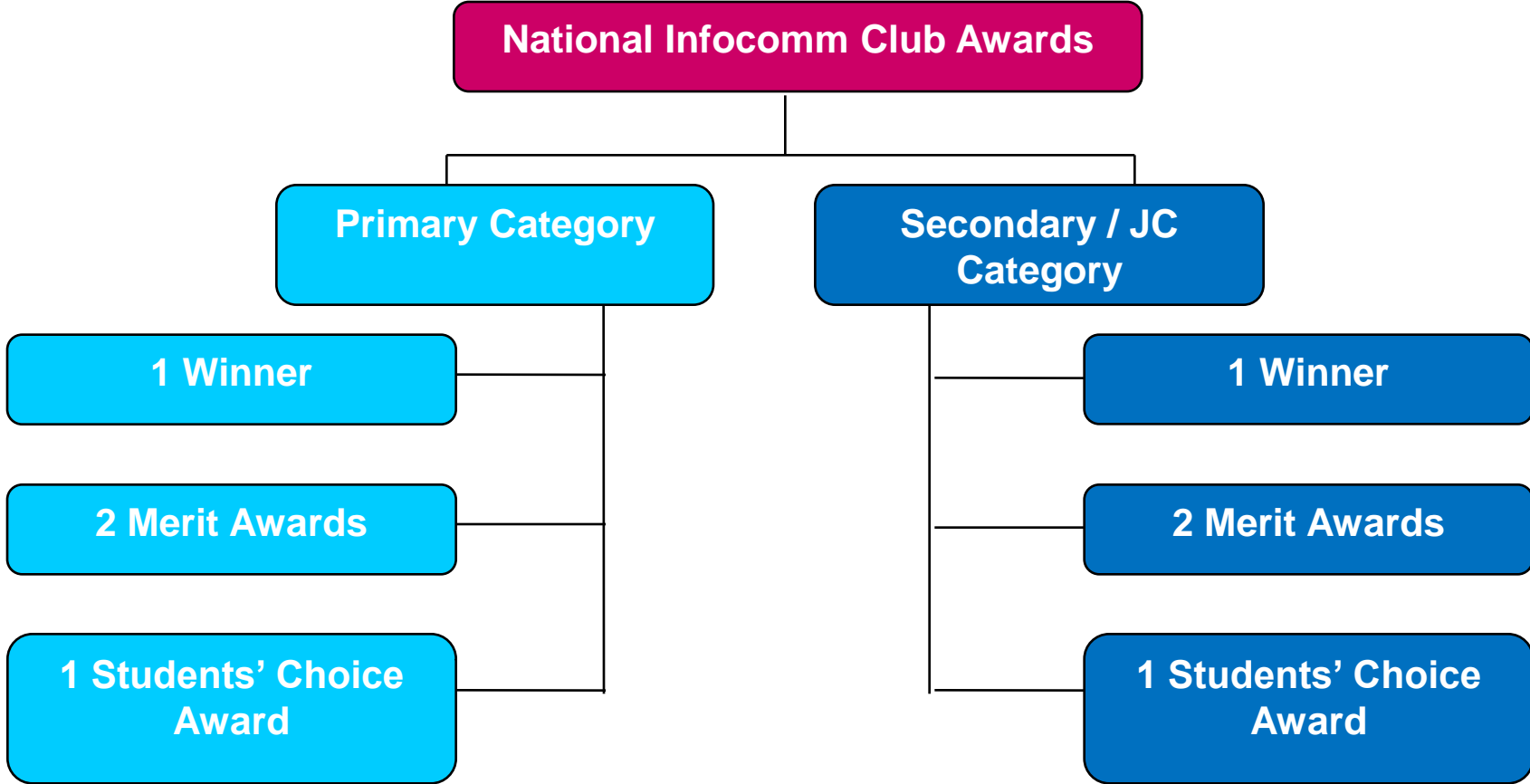

Award Details

- > 2 rounds of judging
 - Internal Judging - Evaluation panel from IDA
 - External Judging - Representative from IDA, MOE, SCS, SITF, SSC

- > Award Distribution per Category
 - 6 best projects (Finalists) will be short-listed from all submitted projects
 - 3 top schools per category will be accorded 1 Distinction and 2 Merit Awards

- > CCA Achievement
 - **Distinction = Gold award**
 - **Merit = Silver award**
 - **Finalist = Bronze award**

Award Guidelines

- > Schools can submit more than one project

- > Projects will be judge based on
 - innovativeness
 - impact
 - level and type of infocomm skills applied
 - potential to be modified or further developed for greater usage by others
 - presentation skills

- > Students would be required to give a 5min presentation on their projects to the judging panel

Award Guidelines

- > Clubs will submit their projects using an entry form signed by the Principal and sent via mail
- > Deadline for submission is 31 Aug 2010
- > Evaluation & Final Judging by 30 Sept 2010
- > Winning Schools will be notified in early Oct 2010
- > Rankings and Prizes will be announced at the NICA Awards Ceremony in Nov 2010
