**No. 2149** — TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT (CHAPTER 323)

TELECOMMUNICATIONS  
(EXEMPTION FROM DOMINANT LICENSEE PROVISIONS  
IN TELECOM COMPETITION CODE 2005 —  
INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE SERVICES)  
NOTIFICATION 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 (5) of the Telecommunications Act, the Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore hereby makes the following Notification:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Notification may be cited as the Telecommunications (Exemption from Dominant Licensee Provisions in Telecom Competition Code 2005 — International Telephone Services) Notification 2006 and shall come into operation on 18th August 2006.

**Interpretation**

2.—(1) In this Notification, unless the context otherwise requires —

“Code” means the Code of Practice for Competition in the Provision of Telecommunication Services 2005 (G.N. No. S 87/2005);

“ITS Notification” means the Telecommunications (Exemption from Dominant Licensee Provisions in Telecom Competition Code 2005 — International Telephone Services) Notification 2005 (G.N. No. 408/2005); and

“Licensee” means Singapore Telecommunications Limited.

“Service” means the WorldConference Multi-Media Conference Service offered by the Licensee.

(2) A reference in this Notification to a section of the Code shall, unless the context otherwise requires, include the specified section and all sub-sections thereof.

**Exemption**

3. For the purposes of paragraph 2 (2) (o) of the ITS Notification, it is notified for general information that —

(a) the Service is within the Retail International Telephone Services market specified in paragraph 2 (2) of the ITS Notification; and

(b) the Licensee is exempted from sections 4.4.1 (a) (i) and (ii), 4.4.1 (b), 4.5 and 4.6 of the Code in relation to the provision of the Service.
