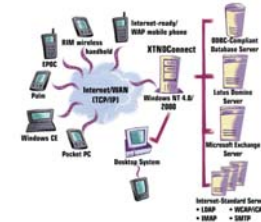

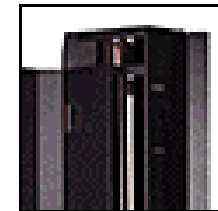

Red-M recently scored another first, by powering the highly successful BlueZone at the 2001 Bluetooth Congress in Monte Carlo.

Conference delegates were able to use a live Bluetooth network to wirelessly download email and access the local Intranet and Internet, including a version of the Bluetooth Congress website designed specifically for access from a handheld device. The network, the largest operational Bluetooth public access system in the world, was based on Red-M's 3000AS access server, 1000AP access points and BIAS™ software technology and featured Bluetooth piconets to enable efficient multi-user connectivity. Users were able to access it from a selection of Bluetooth enabled Palm and Handspring handheld computers, and various laptop computers.



Network statistics

- Around 500 people experienced the BlueZone

- The BlueZone covered some 2,500 sq metres
- The network provided support for 100 simultaneous connections
